- easily accessed


Solution

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Standards of care

Definition

Sets the minimum expectation for client care delivery in a specific area; within a discipline or; across the Hospital. It aims to:

- Provide auditable metrics for success
- Outline interprofessional responsibilities

Program criteria

Standards for the program are prioritized based on the following consensus criteria:

- High volume or high risk population
- Interprofessional lens
- Intervention focused
- High impact potential

Rapid reviews

Available evidence

Definition

A type of knowledge synthesis in which the systematic review process is simplified to produce evidence in a short period of time to enhance timeliness.2
